




#### **GUEST ROOM OVERVIEW\***

#### Robibero Family Vineyards



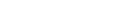

# Hasbrouck House 3805 Main St. Stone Ridge, NY 12484

You're in the country now. This means getting from point A to point B can be a bit challenging without a car. While we have plenty going on at Hasbrouck House to keep you occupied, the Hudson Valley is so rich and full of great experiences that we wouldn't want you to miss!

#### By Car from NYC: (Preferred):

Take I-87 north to Exit 19 to Kingston. (Google Maps generally says to get off at Exit 18, but we prefer Exit 19 as it is a more direct route.) At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto NY-28 W. Use the right lane to merge onto US-209 S via the ramp to Ellenville. Hasbrouck House will be 10 miles down the road on your left.

#### By Bus from NYC:

Take the Trailways bus to Rosendale. From there you'll be a 10 minute drive to Hasbrouck House. We recommend arranging with New Paltz Taxi to get to the hotel. Once at the Hotel, you're a bit limited to where you can travel to without a car, so we highly recommend renting a car if you're looking to explore beyond Stone Ridge.

#### By Air:

Stewart International Airport is 39 miles south of Hasbrouck House. It is in the southern Hudson Valley, west of Newburgh, New York, approximately 60 miles north of Manhattan, New York City.

Albany International Airport is 73 miles north of Hasbrouck House in Albany, New York. We recommend renting a car if traveling from Albany.

Newark Liberty International Airport is 99 miles south of Hasbrouck House in Newark, New Jersey. We recommend renting a car if
